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DATA PROTECTION POLICY
Charity Foundation Source of Revival
(CFSR)

1. INTRODUCTION

Charity Foundation "Source of Revival" (CFSR) undertakes to adhere to the highest standards of data protection and information confidentiality. This policy aims to define our approaches and procedures regarding the collection, processing, storage and protection of personal data.

2. DEFINITION OF PERSONAL DATA

2.1. Personal Data: Personal data includes any information that identifies or makes an individual identifiable. This may include name, address, email, phone numbers, photos, medical information, and more.

2.2. Sensitive Data: Sensitive data is personal data that includes sensitive information such as information about health, financial status, religious beliefs, sexual orientation, etc.

3. DATA COLLECTION AND PROCESSING

3.1. Lawfulness of processing: Charity Foundation "Source of Revival" (CFSR) undertakes to collect and process personal data in accordance with current legislation and only on the grounds provided for by law.

3.2. Minimization of data: Charity Foundation "Source of Revival" (CFSR) undertakes to collect only those data that are necessary for the fulfillment of specific purposes and to limit the amount of information to the necessary minimum.

3.3. Information: Data subjects must be properly informed about the collection, processing and storage of their personal data and about their rights under this policy.

4. DATA PROTECTION

4.1. Confidentiality: Charity Foundation "Source of Revival" (CFSR) is undertaken to ensure the confidentiality of personal data and sensitive information, taking the necessary measures to protect them from unauthorized access.

4.2. Information Safety: Charity Foundation "Source of Revival" (CFSR) pays great attention to information security and applies appropriate technical and organizational measures to prevent unauthorized access, loss, destruction or distribution of personal data.

4.3. Storage terms: Charity Foundation "Source of Revival" (CFSR) determines the storage terms of personal data and after the expiration of the term deletes or anonymizes the data in accordance with internal regulations.

4.4. Ensuring access: Limited access to personal data is granted only to those employees and others who have legal rights to access such information in accordance with their duties.

5. RIGHTS OF DATA SUBJECTS

5.1. Right of access: Data subjects have the right to request access to their personal data and to receive information about how that data is being used.

5.2. Right to rectification: Data subjects have the right to request the rectification of incorrect or incomplete personal data.

5.3. Right to be forgotten: Data subjects have the right to request the deletion of their personal data in cases provided for by law.

6. TRANSPARENCY AND REPORTING

6.1. Reporting: Charity Foundation "Source of Revival" (CFSR) publishes an annual report on its personal data processing activities, including information on data security breaches, if any.

6.2. Communication with data subjects: Charity Foundation "Source of Revival" (CFSR) maintains open communication with data subjects and responds to their requests and requests for data correction.

7. VIOLATION PROCEDURES

7.1. Breach notification: In the event of a data security breach, Charity Foundation "Source of Revival" (CFSR) makes an immediate notification to the relevant regulators and data subjects in accordance with the current legislation.

7.2. Breach Response: Charity Foundation "Source of Revival" (CFSR) takes all necessary measures to correct data security breaches and prevent similar incidents in the future.
